



Tillman Prop R Ribbon Cutting

On Saturday, Feb. 5, Kirkwood School District Board of Education members joined staff and students at Tilman Elementary in officially cutting the ribbo on their new and expanded spaces, which were made possible thanks to th community's support for Prop. R. Tillman students now have eight additiona classrooms used by second, third and fifth grade classes. Construction also included a new gmn, new library/imedia center, which was named in memo of long-time teacher Dan Mueller and the conversion of the former library into new counseling offices, which are named in memory of former Tillman counselor Andrew Johnson. Thanks to the additional classrooms, there are now better locations to offer services that were being offered in smaller and less ideal spaces, including grifted and special education services.

Prop R Updates

Thanks to the support of our community for Prop R, we have been working to deliver on the promises we made to address overcrowding. In our ongoing commitment to transparency, we want to be upfront about our challenges as we pursue effective solutions. As a result of the quickly changing construction



environment, we're making some necessary changes to our planned timeline for construction.

We recently went through the bidding process for projects at North Kirkwood Middle School, Kirkwood High School and Nipher Middle School. Due to a variety of factors, including supply chain concerns and regional labor limitations, the total cost came in notably over budget. While we do have contingency funds, we are concerned the amount of the overage would stretch those funds too tightly, especially with the remaining projects we plan to accomplish.

In an effort to reduce the cost, we are going to revise the completion timeline. Updated completion dates would be:

- North Kirkwood Middle School by May 2023
- Nipher Middle School by October 2023
- Kirkwood High School by October 2023
- Tillman Elementary School by October 2023

These changes will not affect the July 2023 completion date at Westchester Elementary School.

It would also not affect work this summer at Robinson, Keysor and North Glendale elementaries or at Kirkwood Early Childhood Center. Those projects are expected to be completed as planned.

We know this is a disappointment, especially for staff, students and families who were looking forward to getting into these new spaces more quickly. While there are some aspects of construction we cannot control, we can ensure we are clear, direct and transparent when challenges arise and changes are necessary.

These changes may also affect our work on boundary adjustments. We will continue our work to engage with our community and develop new boundaries. Our discussions on how to best implement the updates will be ongoing.

We will continue to communicate with you, both on these updates and as we mark accomplishments. Already this year, we've been able to celebrate successes in the form of new ADA entrances at North Glendale and Robinson elementary schools. We've also completed secured entrances on the Essex side of Kirkwood High School and North Glendale Elementary as well as HVAC improvements throughout the District. This morning, we will mark the completion of phase one of construction at Westchester Elementary, a twoclassroom addition that will provide some immediate relief for a school that has experienced some of our most significant growth in recent years.

Thank you again for your support as we work to deliver on our Prop R promises.






